*The students below were honored with the following awards for outstanding achievement at the conclusion of the 2020 academic year. The associated texts are adaptations from the award citations.*

## VALEDICTORIAN – OLIVIA KALAFIAN

The Valedictorian of the Class of 2020 is **Olivia Kalafian**, a gifted student. Entering in kindergarten, she is the third of her sisters to graduate from New Covenant. Her dedication to her studies was visible across the disciplines. Graduating *summa cum laude* while taking a full academic load each year, she was also the recipient of the Fine Arts Award because of her many accomplishments in music, drama, and studio art. Her “renaissance” character was on display as she took two science courses and AP Calculus in her senior year.

In addition to serving on the yearbook staff for four years, Olivia was a member of the literary magazine staff. She has participated in both the TEAMS engineering competition and the AMC math competition. She was a poetry recital finalist in each of her four years of high school and was the class winner her sophomore year. She diligently served in her roles as a peer tutor, Alexandria House Historian, and founder of the Rhetoric women’s Bible study. She writes, “We cherish God’s faithfulness in every moment of our lives. Let us strive to see Christ in everything we do.”



## EXCELLENCE IN FINE ARTS AWARD – OLIVIA KALAFIAN

The Fine Arts Award is given to the senior who has excelled in the arts throughout the New Covenant School of Rhetoric career. This year’s recipient, **Olivia Kalafian**, has been devoted to music and drama and has made great contributions in studio art as well.

Olivia began participating in drama in middle school as a lovely flower in “Alice in Wonderland” and took on her first singing role in 7th grade. She has been acting and singing for us each year, most notably playing Maria vonTrapp in this year’s production, “The Sound of Music.” Her beautiful voice also found expression in the Rhetoric choir for four years, earning spots in District Chorus each year. Olivia was also selected for the Virginia State Chorus as a senior. A gifted studio artist, she has earned awards in the school art fair for four years, winning two first place awards, in painting and mixed media, in the spring art show. She has also taken the artistic lead on the yearbook project the last two years, working tirelessly to produce a beautiful keepsake.

## SALUTATORIAN – MICHAEL MINNICK

The Salutatorian of the Class of 2020 is **Michael Minnick**, a deeply respected young man. He entered New Covenant in kindergarten and has demonstrated both an aptitude and a willingness to do the necessary work to succeed throughout his career. He understood that one must seek to become an educated adult; it cannot just happen to a person. More than that, it is apparent Michael understood a second cornerstone of education, that its proper target is not simply the mind, but rather the whole person. Michael demonstrated greatness of heart in the hallways, on the field of play where he was an outstanding soccer player, and in student governance.

## EXCELLENCE IN LATIN AWARD – SOFI FOR-

**SHEY** Latin is a pillar of classical education and a primary distinctive of New Covenant Schools. Author and classicist Tracy Lee Simmons calls Latin the *sine qua non* of a classical education. We are pleased to present the Excellence in Latin Award to a student who has completed her fifth year of high school Latin, **Sofi Forshey**.

Sofi is a delightful and witty young woman, and also a gifted and driven student. She brings to her study of Latin a formidable intellect and spirit of adventure. Those two qualities make her an ideal translator of Latin, as she possesses the ability and the willingness to listen carefully and sympathetically to the author and render his ideas into elegant English.



## THE GREEK AWARD – LAUSYN MCBRIDE

The opportunity to study ancient Greek is one of the unique privileges afforded in a classical, Christian curriculum. A full third of the Holy Scriptures were written in this language, and each year some twenty students in the School of Rhetoric undertake studies that culminate in reading

fluency in the New Testament and other ancient documents.

In New Covenant Greek students translate and discuss texts from the Gospels, the letters of St. Paul, the Apocrypha and, very importantly, the Nicene and Chalcedonian Creeds. These critical documents have

defined orthodox Christology for more than 1700 years, and provided the basis for the political liberty that eventually flourished in the West.

Through this process a student's intellect and faith are strengthened. New Covenant annually recognizes the student of New Testament Greek who demonstrates competency, dedication, and facility in the study of ancient Christian scripture as reflected in their grade average and their overall reading ability, and this year's award was presented to **Lausyn McBride**.

## EXCELLENCE IN MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES AWARD – WILL VANVOORHIS



The New Covenant School of Rhetoric maintains a comprehensive math and science program, true to the liberal arts tradition. We present the Excellence in Mathematics & Science Award each year to recognize a student who has consistently demonstrated both an interest in and a keen ability with these subjects. In addition this

student is the recipient of a \$500 scholarship established in memory of **Mrs. Jennifer Hartman**, who faithfully taught mathematics at New Covenant.

This year's honoree is **Will VanVoorhis**. Will is known for his ability to understand difficult concepts. He consistently earned impressive scores in the American Mathematics Competition, and as sophomore placed in the top three at our testing location. His peers routinely seek him out to ask questions, and he willingly explains ideas and processes to them.

## THE TIMOTHY DIEBLER ARÊTE AWARD – MICHAEL MINNICK



The New Covenant Schools' *Arete* Award has been established in memory of one of the founding faculty members of our school, the late **Dr. Timothy Diebler**, who encouraged the excellence that this award recognizes, and which we hope to inspire within all who walk these halls.

The Greek word *arete* means "virtue" or "excellence," specifically those qualities that

make something distinctive. The arete of a cello is the optimal beauty of the sounds a cello can make; the arete of a horse is the power and speed unique to that animal; the arete of a human being is virtue and wisdom. What is the arete of a New Covenant student?

The *Arete* Award is given to a senior who, in the opinion of the faculty, best exemplifies New Covenant's "Portrait of the Graduate." Such a student is prudent in speech and action; is generous and rich in good works; is a lover of truth, goodness and beauty; is eloquent with the written and spoken word; is spiritually strong, looking to God in faith, hope and love; is intellectually vigorous, seeking to know God, self and the world; and encounters success with humility and failure with confidence.

The faculty recognizes this year's recipient for academic excellence, not just the ability to earn top grades, but to grow in wisdom and understanding. We applaud his positive leadership throughout the life of the school, in class, on the athletic field, and in the House Council, and we appreciate the humility and charity with which our recipient leads. The faculty are pleased to confer the 2020 *Arete* Award upon **Michael Minnick**.

## EXCELLENCE IN HUMANITIES AWARD – SOFI FORSHEY

The English poet Matthew Arnold wrote that a superior education is one that introduces people to "the best that has been thought and said." At New Covenant, we aspire to this, setting before our students patterns of excellence and incentives to noble action, inspiring them with the elevating power of the classical, Christian tradition, the love for which sharpens moral vision and forms strong character. Therefore, the Humanities award is given annually to the student who exhibits an extraordinary delight and talent in the study of literature, history and theology.



This year, the Humanities Award is presented to **Sofi Forshey**, who has been both an outstanding student of Western Civilization and a creative contributor of her own works through her efforts as Editor of the *Gryphon's Quill*, the student-run literary publication. She is a voracious reader who has long been known to finish her projects quickly because she enjoys reading and writing. In class discussions, her enthusiasm and deep engagement inspire her fellow students and instructors alike. Her aptitude, her ability to accurately express the best of what has been thought and said, and her unique voice make her a worthy recipient of our honor.

Calvin played varsity soccer and lacrosse at New Covenant, and will play lacrosse for Randolph in the coming year. During his career at New Covenant, Calvin scored 82 career goals with 35 assists, even with his senior year cut short by Covid-19 suspensions. In addition to his athletic accomplishments, Calvin earned the President's Scholarship at Randolph College which provides full tuition for four years.
