FAREWELL TO THE CLASS OF 2021 *by John Heaton, Headmaster*

The following is an excerpt from comments offered at Commencement to the class of 2021.

Just a few short weeks ago we said goodbye to the class of 2021, and marked the end of our thirtieth school term. From our humble beginning in 1991 it has been our goal to re-establish and further our cultural inheritance which, in education, is the classical and Christian tradition. More than 1,000 years ago the Christian Church understood that education and the rearing of children was part of the Gospel mandate. Consequently, the first cathedral schools advanced learning in the West, and set in motion a culture of learning that produced the philosophers, doctors, scientists,

artists, poets and authors that we continue to study today. In our time it is more than fashionable to despise and disparage the Christian faith in general, and the Western tradition in particular. I would suggest, however, that the vast majority of our detractors have no idea that Christianity, through the university system it developed, is in large part responsible for the great achievements that advanced human knowledge and bettered the conditions of millions of human beings across the centuries and across the world.

The faculty and staff celebrate the Valedictorian of the Class of 2021, **Virginia Elizabeth Kittrell**.



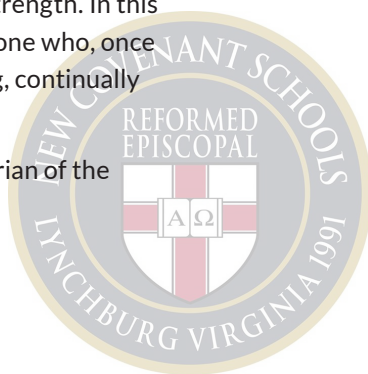
SALUTATORIAN

Presented to Phoebe Prillaman

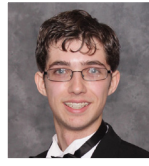

What is the arete of a New Covenant student?

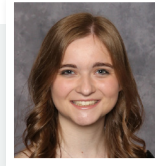

EXCELLENCE IN GREEK AWARD

The opportunity to study ancient Greek is one of the unique privileges afforded by a classical, Christian curriculum. A full third of the Holy Scriptures were written in this language, and each year some twenty students in the School of Rhetoric embark upon studies that culminate in reading fluency in the New Testament and other ancient documents.

In our Greek studies students translate and discuss texts from the Gospels, the letters of St. Paul, the Apocrypha and the Nicene and Chalcedonian Creeds. These critical documents have defined orthodox Christology for more than 1,700 years, and provided the basis for the political liberty that eventually flourished in the West.

Through this process a student’s intellect and faith is strengthened. New Covenant annually recognizes the student of New Testament Greek who demonstrates competency, dedication, and facility in the study of ancient Christian scripture as reflected in their grade average and their overall reading ability.

This year’s recipient of the Excellence in Greek Award is **Tessa Hackenbracht**.

The English poet Matthew Arnold wrote that a superior education is one that introduces people to “the best that has been thought and said.” We aspire to this at New Covenant, setting before our students patterns of excellence and incentives to noble action. We inspire them with the elevating power of the classical Christian tradition, and the love for learning which sharpens moral vision and forms strong character. Therefore, the Humanities award is given annually to the student who exhibits an extraordinary delight and talent in the study of literature, history and theology.

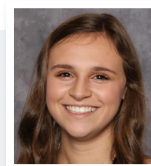

that 16 of the 26 graduates were enrolled in kindergarten or the first grade. When they matriculated to kindergarten in the fall of 2008, the country was deep in recession, and Barack Obama was elected the 44th president of the US. YouTube was only two years old, and iPhones were new. Google Chrome, Spotify and Android were released. There were 340 students at New Covenant at that time, and by the time they graduated there were 446. All members of this class played at least one sport in their high school careers or performed in the band and orchestra through the senior year. Two members of this class, **Jadon Walker** and **Thad Heaton** broke school records—Jadon, for most points in a basketball game (49) and most career points with 1,440; Thad with a record in the 400m dash time of 51.19 seconds and a state championship. Jadon will play next year at the collegiate level at Hampton-Sydney College. Members of this class were accepted to 28 colleges, universities, and technical schools, and together they have earned more than

\$1,328,200 in merit scholarships and financial awards.

I often told these students that life is a series of “whatevers.” The scriptures say, “Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might as unto the Lord.” You don’t know where you will be tomorrow. You can make a plan, but whatever it is that comes into life, embrace it, and take advantage of the opportunity. Walk through the open door; knock on the closed door. Don’t overthink it. Engage the next thing to the fullest, and after a short period of years you’ll be able to look back and see how each thread in the tapestry of your life contributes to the formation of the whole. Do the next thing, and the next thing. Avoid moral mistakes and sins that will beset you. Walk faithfully. Commit your way unto the Lord and he will bring your life to fruitfulness. God bless you all.
