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### School of Rhetoric Uniform Guide 2022-23: 9-12th Grade Gentlemen

#### **Monday & Wednesday (non-dress days)**

- NCS navy or white polo
- Flynn & O'Hara khaki pants or shorts
- Solid black or brown belt\*
- NCS-issued navy hooded sweatshirt or NCS-issued sports outerwear
- Gray Flynn & O'Hara sweater or vest
- Sperry authentic original boat shoe (brown or beige only)\*

#### **Tuesday & Thursday (dress days)**

- Flynn & O'Hara white oxford
- Flynn & O'Hara khaki pants or shorts
- Solid black or brown belt\*
- Navy blazer\*
- Navy/red/green/yellow striped tie or bow tie
- Sperry authentic original boat shoe (brown or beige only)\*
- Gray Flynn & O'Hara sweater or vest (may be worn with the blazer NOT in place of the blazer)

#### **Friday (casual day)**

- Any *NCS issued* T-shirt or NCS sports team issued jersey (Exception: *In the second semester*, seniors may wear t-shirts/sweatshirts from the colleges to which they applied.)
- Flynn & O'Hara khaki pants or shorts
- Solid black or brown belt\*
- NCS issued navy hooded sweatshirt or NCS issued sports outerwear
- Any *closed-toe* shoe (no crocs or sandals, etc.)

**\*All uniform items must be purchased from [www.flynnohara.com](http://www.flynnohara.com) or the NCS Store EXCEPT items marked with an asterisk (belts, shoes, blazers and socks). The NCS store provides the navy and white polos, and navy hooded sweatshirts. Socks must be worn each day.**

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## Guy's Shoe Options

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*This is the official **Sperry** uniform shoe for Monday through Thursday and is available through our vendor's website, [www.flynnohara.com](http://www.flynnohara.com). If you choose, you may purchase from a different source. Alternative brands are allowed; however, they should look virtually the same as the shoes provided by our vendor. They should be leather and not suede or fabric. They may not be the 'sneaker' version. Alternate brands include Timberland, and Dockers (not Hey Dudes).*
