

GRAMMAR SCHOOL ART AND MUSIC

New Covenant's mission includes teaching students about what is good and beautiful, giving them a taste for what to love. Art and music classes in the Grammar School begin with this end in mind.

Grammar school art classes introduce students to the work of artists across the span of history. These masterworks display a variety of techniques and inspire appreciation. Students create their own works in response, using a wide variety of media, from paper and pencil to textiles and clay. Children display their work each spring at the Art Fair.

Music classes in grammar school are active and often a little noisy. Children enjoy singing and moving with simple songs that teach basic music theory, playing rhythm instruments and recorders, and listening attentively to works from great compositional masters. In fourth grade, they choose to play in band or string orchestra, to develop skill with one instrument. Students delight us with musical presentations at Christmas and in the spring.
